
## Investigation & Diagnosis


Visit your GP as the first point of contact.

Not MS, illness managed and treated as appropriate. Referral to Medical Specialist Group (MSG) consultant who will make a diagnosis, arrange further investigations, such as MRI, and lumbar puncture as needed. The MSG consultant will be instrumental in your ongoing care and management.



Referral to local visiting neurologist for confirmation of diagnosis and discussion about management/ treatment, and ongoing support. They may request further tests which may have to be carried out in Southampton.





## Management & Ongoing care

Referral from either the MSG consultant or neurologist to Debbie Robilliard, MS specialist nurse, for ongoing support AND advice about condition, facilitation of Disease Modifying Therapy (DMT) and signposting for further treatment OR intervention.

> Ongoing support from your GP and from the specialist nurse, but you can be refrred back to any of the services at any time. This is known as continuous care.
